1. About National Cooperative Exports Limited

National Cooperative Exports Limited (NCEL) is a multi-State cooperative society registered under the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002. NCEL is jointly promoted by GCMMF (Amul), IFFCO, KRIBHCO, NAFED, and NCDC — representing the apex of India's cooperative institutional ecosystem. NCEL is mandated to strengthen institutional capacities of cooperative societies for organised market participation — domestic and international — across agricultural and allied sectors.

2. Purpose of this Expression of Interest

NCEL is implementing a Cooperative Supply-Chain and Processing Ecosystem Strengthening Programme. As part of this Programme, NCEL proposes to identify and empanel rice processing units capable of providing full-scope processing services to cooperative society clients within a structured institutional framework. This EOI is issued to map and assess eligible processing units for potential empanelment.

3. Nature and Scope of this EOI

Applicants are advised to note the following:

- This EOI is issued solely for institutional assessment and ecosystem mapping purposes.
- This is not a tender, procurement notice, or commercial bid invitation.
- This does not constitute an offer of work, processing contract, or procurement commitment of any kind.
- Submission of an EOI does not create any right, entitlement, or expectation of empanelment or allocation of processing volume.
- NCEL reserves full and absolute discretion in evaluation, shortlisting, empanelment, or non-selection at every stage.
- NCEL does not guarantee any definite volume of work during any period.
- Empanelment, if granted, shall be for ecosystem alignment and institutional participation purposes only and shall not constitute a processing contract.
- Any institutional arrangement, if extended, shall be subject to separate documentation, terms, and approvals.
- NCEL reserves the right to modify, withdraw, or cancel this EOI at any stage without prior notice and without liability.

4. PROGRAMME PERIOD

- a) This Expression of Interest (EOI) is being issued solely for the purpose of identification, assessment, and empanelment of eligible processing units.
- b) The empanelment of selected applicants shall be valid for a period of [●] years, which shall commence from the date of execution of the **Empanelment Agreement** between NCEL and the selected applicant.
- c) It is clarified that this EOI does not constitute any binding commitment for award of work. The actual allocation of processing work, if any, shall be governed by separate work orders and/or processing agreements to be executed from time to time.
- d) The empanelment shall not guarantee any minimum quantity of work or exclusivity, and NCEL reserves the right to allocate work at its sole discretion.

5. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

To be eligible for consideration under this EOI, the applicant must satisfy all of the following conditions:

5.1 Legal and Organisational Standing

- ❖ The applicant must be a legally constituted entity — sole proprietorship, partnership firm registered under the Indian Partnership Act 1932, company registered under the Companies Act 1956/2013,

Limited Liability Partnership registered under the LLP Act 2008, or cooperative society registered under the relevant Act.

- ❖ Consortium applications are not permitted. Each application must be from a single legal entity.
- ❖ The applicant must possess all required statutory permissions, licences, and regulatory approvals from concerned State and Central Government authorities to undertake rice milling, processing, and storage operations.
- ❖ The applicant must not be blacklisted, debarred, suspended, or have been subject to adverse regulatory action by any Central or State Government body, Public Sector Undertaking, or apex cooperative institution at any time.
- ❖ The applicant must not be involved in any material litigation that could affect or compromise the delivery of processing services or the continuity of operations.
- ❖ The applicant must not have been prosecuted for violation of the Essential Commodities Act or any analogous law or order in any court of law.

5.2 Processing Infrastructure

- ❖ The applicant must own or hold under a registered lease agreement (with residual lease of not less than twelve months) a rice processing unit with a minimum installed milling and processing capacity of 150 Metric Tonnes per Day (MTPD) per unit.
- ❖ Each processing unit must be equipped with functional Sortex and grading line(s) with a combined capacity commensurate with the milling capacity of the unit for enabling the delivery of fully graded, sorted, and export-quality processed rice.
- ❖ The applicant must have dedicated paddy/Rice receiving and pre-processing facilities capable of handling large-volume cooperative society supplies in a single intake cycle.
- ❖ The applicant must have either covered or open warehousing facilities — either on-premises or at a proximate location under its operational control — with a combined storage capacity of not less than one week of their Processing Capacity of paddy and/or rice.
- ❖ The applicant must have in-house or readily accessible packing capabilities covering bulk, retail, and customised packaging formats as may be required by cooperative society clients or their buyers.

5.3 Financial Standing

1. The applicant must have a minimum average annual turnover of **Rs. 20 crore (Rupees Twenty Crore)** over the last three completed financial years, as evidenced by audited financial statements certified by a Chartered Accountant.
2. The applicant must have a positive net worth in any of the **last three (3)** completed financial years.

5.4 Quality and Compliance Credentials

- ❖ The applicant's processing unit must hold a valid FSSAI licence for rice processing and storage.
- ❖ The applicant must hold or be in active process of obtaining ISO 22000:2018 or equivalent food safety management system certification for the processing unit.
- ❖ The applicant must have an established internal quality testing protocol — including moisture content, broken percentage, foreign matter, and grain length measurement.
- ❖ The applicant must demonstrate the capacity to maintain lot-wise traceability from paddy intake through to final packed output, with documented batch records available for inspection.

5.5 Operational and Logistics Capability

- ❖ The applicant must demonstrate a maximum monthly dispatch capacity of not less than 3,500 Metric Tonnes per month through road and/or rail, with documented logistics arrangements or own fleet.
- ❖ The applicant must be located within reasonable proximity to paddy-producing cooperative society catchment areas, agricultural market yards (mandis), or cooperative society aggregation points or ports— with specific mention of the districts, Nearby Ports and States served.
- ❖ The applicant must disclose proximity to major railheads.

5.6 Cooperative Sector Orientation and Cluster Potential

NCEL specifically values processing units that demonstrate — or have the operational potential to develop — structured engagement with cooperative societies and rural agricultural supply chains. In this regard, applicants are requested to provide information on:

- ❖ Prior experience in processing paddy or rice sourced from cooperative societies, farmer producer organisations (FPOs), primary agricultural credit societies (PACS), or similar institutional supply chains with details of volumes handled, duration of engagement, and nature of arrangement.
- ❖ Geographic positioning of the processing unit relative to cooperative society concentration areas, rice-growing cluster districts, and major cooperative society procurement hubs in the State including details of cooperative societies within a 50-kilometre radius of the processing unit.
- ❖ Existing or potential infrastructure for organised paddy reception from cooperative society supply chains including weighbridge, quality checking, moisture testing, and intake documentation capabilities.
- ❖ Willingness and operational readiness to adopt cooperative-supply-specific intake protocols, documentation standards, lot segregation practices, and traceability requirements as may be prescribed by NCEL.
- ❖ Any existing MoUs, agreements, or working relationships with cooperative societies, State cooperative federations, PACS, or FPOs — with supporting documentation.

The ability to serve as an anchor processing node for a cluster of cooperative societies in a defined geographic area enabling aggregation, standardisation, and coordinated supply-chain management — will be treated as a significant positive factor in evaluation.

6. DISQUALIFICATION CRITERIA

NCEL may, at its sole discretion and at any stage of the evaluation process, disqualify any applicant if:

- ❖ The applicant has made misleading, false, or incomplete representations in the EOI or supporting documents.
- ❖ The applicant fails to submit all required documents within the prescribed deadline.
- ❖ The applicant fails to provide requested clarifications within the timeframe specified by NCEL.
- ❖ Any director, partner, proprietor, or key managerial person of the applicant has been declared ineligible, blacklisted, or subjected to penal action by the Government of India, any State Government, or any public sector institution.
- ❖ The applicant is found to have engaged in any corrupt, fraudulent, anti-competitive, or unethical conduct in relation to this EOI or any prior engagement with any government or institutional body.

8. AUTHORISATION AND SIGNING REQUIREMENTS

The EOI must be signed by the authorised signatory of the applicant entity. The authorised signatory must submit:

- ❖ A duly executed Authority Letter / Board Resolution / Partner Authorisation, as applicable, authorising the signatory to submit the EOI and bind the entity in all matters pertaining to the empanelment process.
- ❖ In the case of a company or LLP, a copy of the Resolution passed by the Board of Directors / Designated Partners authorising the signatory, along with a copy of the Memorandum of Association / LLP Agreement.
- ❖ The Authority Letter must be signed by all directors / partners, or by a person authorised to bind the entity. Applications without a valid Authority Letter will be summarily rejected.
- ❖ All pages of the EOI submission must be signed and stamped by the authorised signatory.

9. EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications will be evaluated by a duly constituted Evaluation Committee of NCEL. The evaluation will consider, inter alia, the following factors — not listed in any order of priority and not exhaustive:

- ❖ Processing capacity, infrastructure quality, and operational capability
- ❖ Sortex and grading capability relative to export-quality requirements
- ❖ Storage and raw material holding capacity
- ❖ Quality management systems, certifications, and compliance record
- ❖ Financial standing and operational stability
- ❖ Logistics and dispatch capability, including proximity to relevant agricultural clusters and ports / ICDs
- ❖ Cooperative sector engagement experience and cluster formation potential
- ❖ Geographic positioning relative to cooperative society supply catchment areas
- ❖ Traceability and documentation discipline
- ❖ Any other criteria NCEL may determine appropriate

NCEL reserves the right to:

- ❖ Conduct site visits and physical verification of any processing unit at its discretion
- ❖ Seek additional information or clarification from any applicant
- ❖ Accept or reject any or all applications without assigning reasons
- ❖ Shortlist applicants for further engagement without constituting an obligation to proceed to empanelment
- ❖ Empanel any number of processing units as it deems appropriate for programme requirements

10A. TIMELINE AND NEXT STAGE PROCESS

This Expression of Interest (EOI) shall remain open for submission up to 30th August 2026

NCEL intends to undertake an expedited assessment of responses received under this EOI. Based on the outcome of such assessment, NCEL may, at its sole discretion, issue a **Request for Quotation (RFQ)** and/or any other subsequent procurement or engagement document to shortlisted applicants.

It is clarified that issuance of the RFQ shall be limited to shortlisted applicants and shall be subject to separate terms, conditions, and evaluation criteria as may be prescribed by NCEL.

11. CONFIDENTIALITY

All documents and information submitted by applicants shall be used by NCEL solely for institutional assessment and programme development purposes. Post-selection, empanelled processing units will be required to execute a Non-Disclosure Agreement with NCEL covering all confidential programme-related information handled during the empanelment period. The applicant shall not disclose any information relating to this EOI without prior written consent of NCEL.

12. IMPORTANT CONDITIONS

1. Empanelment is non-exclusive. NCEL shall be free to engage or empanel any number of processing units, at its sole discretion, without any obligation towards empanelled entities.

2. Empanelment does not confer any right, guarantee, or assurance of allocation of any quantity, volume, or value of processing work.
3. NCEL may seek additional information or conduct site visits or due diligence at any stage.
4. All empanelled processing units will be required to execute an Empanelment Agreement in the format prescribed by NCEL.
5. Empanelled entities will also be required to execute an Integrity Pact as per Annexure 6.

13. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The applicant shall disclose whether any director, partner, proprietor, or key managerial person is directly or indirectly related to, affiliated with, or has any financial interest in any employee, officer, director, or governing body member of NCEL or its promoter organisations. Any arrangement that may give rise to a conflict of interest must be disclosed. Failure to disclose a material conflict of interest may result in disqualification.

14. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This EOI and any empanelment arising therefrom shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Courts at New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute arising out of or in connection with this EOI.
